The Fair concert and steak dinner will be Wednesday, August 6th, 1997. The stage will come in on Tuesday, August 5th, 1997, and will be torn down after the concert. Roughstock will be the band.

It looks like there may be some State funding for fairs this year.

There was a meeting with the Siting Committee and the engineer who is working on the Armory Siting. According to the inspection done by the engineer, the Community Center and the grandstand are very structurally sound, and should be good for many years to come.

The preliminary Master Plan meeting will be April 11, 1997. The time is to be announced.

The Budget Hearing will be April 28, 1997 at 9:50 a.m. We will have 20 minutes.

The 1997 Fair theme will be "A Barnful of Fun". We also may have some t-shirts made up, with a slightly different picture.

The Eagles have been lined up to do concessions for the April Rodeo. We will get 30% of the net from the concessions; 10% of the beer garden.

Nellie moved that the parking lot area will cost \$500.00 for The

Elks beer garden for Miners' Jubilee. Tables and chairs will cost extra, <u>if available</u>. Chuck seconded. Passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
