

BAKER COUNTY
FAIRBOARD MEETING
JUNE 4, 1997

The meeting was called to order at 7:20 P.M. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as sent. Fred moved, Chuck seconded, that we pay the bills. Passed unanimously.

It was brought up that we need to come up with some sort of contract regarding the return of Hog Panels, etc. borrowed or otherwise used. They need to be at least disinfected, if not steam cleaned.

We have been approached about using our pens, etc., as a livestock holding area. We do not feel that this is an appropriate use of our pens.

The Church Group will do burgers & polish sausages for the 4th of July Rodeo.

Curt will work on setting up security for fair time. Allen suggested that we need to set up a curfew of 9:30 P.M. for this years fair. Fred seconded - passed unanimously

There will be no camping in the Rodeo Arena this year. All campers will have to be across the street next to the Armory or at the North End. Horse Trailers will be allowed to be parked inside the grounds between the Bus Barn and the fence. Tow vehicles will have to be removed, and driving in and out will not be allowed. Once the Trailer is parked, it's there till the fair is over. People will have to be sure their feed, etc. is in the trailer.

The Armory Siting Committee accepted our proposed plan and the Engineer is supposed to be sending a revised plan. If the Armory Siting goes through our Pavilion will have to be built as Phase 1. Phase 2 would be the remodel of the Community Center. These would have to be done before the work on the Armory would be started.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 P.M. The next meeting is Wednesday JULY 2 at 7:00 P.M
